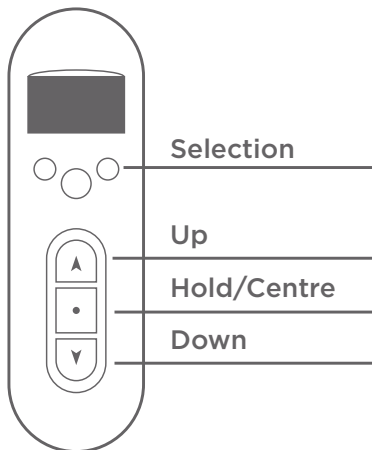

CARE GUIDE

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Retractable Blinds

- Always operate blinds from centre
- If retractable from one side the blind will retract unevenly
- Retractable blinds may be difficult to operate in windy conditions (you may need to apply pressure to the centre of the mesh to help the blind up).

Electronic Blinds

- Avoid operation in high winds
- Always supervise electronic blinds when in operation
- Motorised blinds will not operate in a power outage (there is no manual override)
- Do not try and alter pre set selections on remote
- Use selection button to select which blind to operate (If help is required, contact your installer)

Maintenance

- As blinds have been rolled up for transport, they will need to be left down for 48 hours to allow material to settle (unless high winds are predicted)
- Blinds must be fully retracted into pelmet in severe weather (not doing so will void warranty)
- Use silicone lubricant to lubricate track if you find sticky or as required (never use oil based lubricants)
- Use soapy water and a hose to clean blinds
- Do not use chemicals on or near blinds
- Keep blinds clean for best life
